

This is the third of six articles on the Minor Prophet Book, Haggai

Let US Build the Temple

Building on a relationship with Jesus takes will and work. You have to want it and own it. Take any outside adventure that you share with others. On your end, it's something you want to do. You plan it, get excited, and when the time comes, you enjoy the journey. You also own the trip. You bring many supplies and you prepare yourself mentally and physically. But there is also another ingredient that makes this adventure, as well as any relationship, work well: a shared spirit of enthusiasm.

On Haggai 1:7-11

Haggai is telling the people that their way of going about being the people of God isn't working out. Their pursuits are off track, their priorities are mixed up, and they're not finding fulfillment. But God insists that if they'll put their mind and strength to the work, God will be pleased and they will delight in God. They won't find their pleasure in their "own houses", but rather in relationship with God and with the people of God.

On Haggai 1:12-15

Real change occurred when the people took Haggai's message to heart. Rather than fearing their circumstances, they feared God. Rather than obeying their desires, they obeyed God. Rather than building on their individual lives, they came together as a people. And it was in this joint repentance that God blessed them with his presence and further stirred up a shared spirit of enthusiasm.
