The Relationship isn't Always Uphill

Reaching the top of a mountain is an exhilarating experience. The view is breathtaking. So is the altitude! The path to get there, however, is not a straight climb. It's uphill and downhill, through switchbacks, through creeks, and over boulders. Walking in your relationship with Jesus is much the same way. You have been 100% forgiven in Him, but you're not complete. His Spirit is still working on you through life's trials to make you more like Jesus. So, you can't expect perfection even as you're climbing the mountain. But what you can expect is the faith of Jesus when your foot slips.

On Haggai 2:10-19

Haggai evidently noticed that the people were drifting as they continued to work on the temple. The people were struggling. This time, it's not being pre-occupied with life, being selfish with their things, or having doubts about their value. They're unclean; but from what, we don't know. Whatever it was, their uncleanness was polluting the temple project. So, Haggai rallies the priests to make the corrections, reminding the people of their lack of wholeness before they began the project, and how God had blessed them with satisfaction since they began. God even assured them, in spite of their uncleanness, that He would bless them from this day forward. God would remain faithful to them.
