Wisdom

*“But Rehoboam rejected the advice the elders gave him”
 (1 Kings 12:8)*

The Bible description of the wealth, prominence and power of the kingdom of Solomon is nothing short of breathtaking. *“King Solomon excelled all the kings of the earth in riches and wisdom. And the whole earth sought the presence of Solomon to hear his wisdom, which God had put into his mind” (1 Kings 10:23-24).* But all of this changed when his son, Rehoboam, became king.

Rehoboam's story in 1 Kings 12 is a striking example of ignoring the wisdom of elders in favor of impulsive, pride-driven decisions. When the Israelites approached him, asking for a lighter yoke than the heavy burdens his father, Solomon, had placed on them, Rehoboam sought advice from two groups: the elders who had served Solomon, and his younger peers, with whom he had grown up.

The elders counseled him to serve the people and speak kindly to them, fostering goodwill and loyalty. Their advice reflected not only their experience but also an understanding of the delicate balance between leadership and servitude. They essentially urged him to adopt a servant-leader mindset, ensuring the stability of his reign.

However, Rehoboam rejected their counsel and instead followed the advice of his younger companions, who told him to assert dominance by increasing the people's burdens. Their approach was brash and lacked foresight, appealing more to Rehoboam's pride than to wisdom. The result was catastrophic: the ten northern tribes rebelled, leading to the division of Israel into two kingdoms, Israel and Judah.

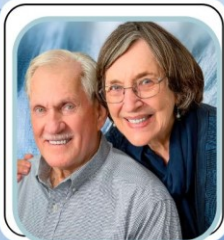

Rehoboam's failure to listen to the wisdom of age demonstrates a timeless lesson. Pride and the allure of power can blind leaders to sound advice. Wisdom, especially when rooted in experience and humility, is invaluable in leadership. His decision not only fractured a nation but also highlights the dangers of surrounding oneself with echo chambers rather than diverse perspectives, including those shaped by years of experience.

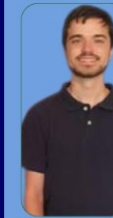
