

I am thankful that our current classes are studying 1 and 2 Peter. One of my favorite scriptures in the Bible is found in 2 Peter.

John 21:15-17 records some of Jesus' last verbal communication with Peter. Jesus not only challenges Peter to faithful discipleship but also expands that commitment to a responsibility of evangelizing and shepherding. Although Peter's profession had been a fisherman and evidently he was not the greatest communicator, 1 and 2 Peter reveal that he accepted and met this challenge effectively.

Jesus' question, "Do you love Me?" reveals that we must have a personal relationship with Jesus as the Messiah but also challenges us with "Feed my sheep." This challenge lets us know that it is not all just about us. We must share the good news. The Messiah has come.

2 Peter 1:3-11 must become a hallmark scripture not only for our growth and discipline as followers of Christ while walking the pathways of life but also for reminding us that we are benefactors of Christ's divine nature. Thus, Peter is confident we will be effective and productive in our knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.
