DO WE CONSIDER THE GOSPEL "GOOD NEWS"?

In this era of social media, I think we all know what good news is - and (these days) what everybody else's good news is! The good thing about Facebook, What's App, Instagram, TikTok is that (perhaps unlike the national news) there are plenty of feel-good stories about children, animals and little, as well as sometimes great, successes. In our families, good news consists of the birth of a baby, baptism, the graduation of a student, entry to college, getting engaged and then (perhaps best of all!) a wedding. These are events we can all relate to and we love to share with others. In our Christian lives, do we consider the gospel of Jesus to be in the same category? Do we get as excited about the gospel as the events listed above? Paul certainly did: he went from town to town spreading the news of the risen Christ and never hesitated or became less enthusiastic, even when his companions urged him to slow down, and even when he was in physical danger. It would be wonderful if we could be equally excited about the Christian message and told everyone about it, enthusiastically, happily, and whole-heartedly. Let us ask God to help us share our passion for the gospel.


