We've all likely built certain things up in our minds only to be let down because our dreams of it were bigger than the reality. That shirt on Amazon that fit the model perfectly, but it looks "blah" on you. There was a person you had a crush on, but once you went on a date, your interest was crushed. Maybe there was some tech device you just had to have and it ended up being junk. We create expectations in our minds, but when something doesn't measure up, we feel like we've been let down. Or maybe...we feel like we have failed?

On Haggai 2:1-9

The people were fired up. The governor, the high priest, and all the people got busy and worked together to restore the temple. But then, one month in, the reality set in. It wasn't looking like anything they imagined Solomon's temple to be and they were beginning to get discouraged. Of course, none of them had ever seen Solomon's temple to compare. They had only heard the stories. The stories made it sound like it was perfect, but this temple was looking blah.

God stepped in and encouraged them. Be strong. Don't be afraid. I'm with you. Do the work. I'll fill this house with my glory, and its final glory will be better than the first. God was telling them that He didn't need this work to be perfect in their eyes. He didn't even need Solomon's temple! He just wanted their hearts.




