



### Sukkot and Thanksgiving

Under Mosaic law, there were 3 required pilgrimage feasts. One of them was the Feast of Tabernacles, or Sukkot in Hebrew. It is a rich, multi-dimensional celebration that brings together themes of history, nature, spirituality, and community. It takes place in late September/early October, and is a time of great joy and thanksgiving for God's faithfulness. It commemorates God's care and watchfulness over the Children of Israel as they wandered in the desert for 40 years.

The celebration itself requires the building of temporary shelters of three walls and a roof which must allow people to see the sky, to remind the faithful of God's provision throughout the long period of 40 years (see *Leviticus 23:33-43*). During the 7-day festival, ritual use is made of four 'species' (a citron, symbolizing the heart or desire; a palm branch, symbolizing action; myrtle branches, symbolizing the eyes and insight; and willow branches, symbolizing the lips and speech). These are bound together and waved in six directions to show God is to be found wherever one turns. Prayers of thanksgiving, and for rain to water crops, is a central theme. Even today, and even in cities, this popular and joyous festival plays an important role in the Jewish calendar, with sukkot being built on balconies, on flat roofs, on parking spots or in public parks.

The USA festival of Thanksgiving has deep roots in Christianity and Judeo-Christian traditions. Thanksgiving originated as a harvest festival, a tradition in which communities gave thanks to God for their crops. Like the early Feast of Tabernacles, it is a time of family, food, remembrance, and inventorying our blessings. In a world that tends to lose the meaningful roots of holidays, I invite you to rediscover the beauty of a time set aside for reflection, heaven-ward gratitude, and family rest. Happy Thanksgiving.


