You are God's Chosen

This is the last of six articles on the Minor Prophet Book, Haggai

YOU ARE MINE

This is the final installment of a light visit into one of my favorite books of the Bible. Haggai is powerful and relates so well to our lives. Thanks for following along.

It's always nice to be picked. It gives a person the feeling that they are seen, wanted, or special. We might experience this in relationships, games, academics, and community. Usually, when someone is picked, it is not simply an affirmation of something about their identity. It also says something about an assigned function. A person is chosen for a purpose. Because we have committed ourselves to Jesus, we belong to God's chosen. We have an identity with Him, and we belong for a God-given purpose.

On Haggai 2:20-23

Zerubbabel was the next son in the line of David. He couldn't be king, but at least David's rule continued in some capacity over Judah. As someone who was denied his rightful claim as a messiah (anointed king), Zerubbabel could benefit from an encouraging word from God. God assured him that his God is at work to bring about judgment and deliverance, and that somehow, he was part of that work. Then God described him as his servant and how he would make him like God's signet ring. He would be God's signature, a working sign that God was still faithful to his covenants with Abraham, Israel, and David. In spite of all the troubles that God's people experienced, Zerubbabel could trust that his people were still God's chosen people, that God's Spirit was with them, and that God was indeed at work to fulfill their hopeful future.
