The Unknowable God

Here are some things to consider. Traveling by plane from LAX, as many of us have done, to Singapore is 8800 miles and takes 18 hours. This is a long time. Yet this distance, and this time, is minuscule on a cosmic scale. The sun is 93 million miles from us, and light takes 8 minutes to get here, at a speed of more than 186,000 miles a second. This, in turn, is a tiny distance - because from here to the nearest comparable galaxy to our own Milky Way is 25,000 light years - that is 164,606,148,868,000,000 miles. Remember: this is the **nearest** galaxy to us. The furthest galaxy visible to us is more than 13 billion light years away - I have calculated that as 76,424,283,403,000,000,000,000 miles. And this is just our universe: we are told there are infinite others beyond.

These figures demonstrate that we humans are utterly incapable of imagining such things - and yet God can imagine them, does imagine them and directs it all. No wonder then that we are forever unable to comprehend God, or imagine him: *Job 11* says it all: “*Can you fathom the mysteries of God? Can you probe the limits of the Almighty? They are higher than the heavens above—what can you do? They are deeper than the depths below—what can you know? Their measure is longer than the earth and wider than the sea.*” We need, we desperately need, Jesus even to begin to approach the unknowable; Jesus the man, the perfect man, yet perfect God.

The Knowable God

The ways of God are so far beyond the ways of man that God, as we have illustrated above, is completely unknowable. It is for this reason that Jesus came, born of a woman in the fullness of time (*Galatians 4:4*) that we might
