

This is the second of six articles on the Minor Prophet Book, Haggai

#### **Consider Your Ways**

Life is complicated. With busy schedules, high expectations, and challenging relationships, unhealthy desires, bitter feelings, and poor self-esteem, life is a struggle. Add to that things like bullying, gossiping, rivalries, and grudges that trouble us, and life becomes very complex. You might wonder, "When will it all line up the way it should be?" (aka: get all my ducks in a row) Or maybe you have your own pity party: "Will I ever catch a break?!" We might not mean for them to affect us, but life's difficulties can divert our attention away from God.

#### On Haggai 1:1-6

God sent Haggai to encourage the people of Jerusalem as they struggled to make sense of their problems. They were evidently preoccupied with life's problems. They were working hard, but with little to see from it. They had food, water, and clothing, but never enough. They couldn't find happiness. So, they put off building the temple. They said, "The time is not now." Instead of coming together to restore God as their center, they pushed aside God so they could build their own houses.

Haggai encouraged them to rethink their situation. Perhaps the reason why they had no relief was because they were looking for peace in the things they thought they could control instead of God.
