The Book of Romans concludes with Paul sending greetings to 26 different individuals. Who are these people?

A Diverse group

Reading through the book of Acts, we may come to believe that the success of Paul's ministry rested solely upon himself and a few others. Truth is, many supporters and co-workers worked diligently for the success of the gospel – men, women, married couples, relatives of Paul, a mother-figure to Paul, among others. Let's look briefly at this diverse group.

Diverse support

- Men and Women – One look through the list of greetings shows the support and dedication of both men and women. In fact, 16 are men and 10 are women. The women include Phoebe, the deaconess, Priscilla, Mary, Junias, Tryphena, Tryphosa, Persis, Rufus's mother, Julia, Nereus's sister.
- Relatives – Three individuals are listed as relatives of Paul: Andronicus, Junias, and Herodian – two of whom had been in prison with Paul.
- Church Host Families – Several in the list hosted the churches in their homes: Priscilla and Aquila, Gaius.
- Fellow Workers – Several in the list are commended for their "hard work" for the cause of the church and the gospel: Priscilla and Aquila, Mary, Tryphena, Tryphosa, Persis, Rufus.
- Jews and Romans – 11 out of the 26

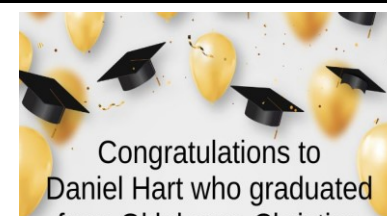
