### Asaph

Asaph is described as a seer or prophet (2 Chronicles 29:30) - one with a specific God-given gift of music. He was inspired by God in both the words and the music of the psalms attributed to him. He lived around 1000 BC, but his influence lasted long past his own physical life in service to King David (in 1 Chronicles 6, beginning with verse 31, we read the names of the tabernacle musicians; verse 39 concerns Asaph.) After Asaph's death, a tradition of tabernacle/temple music in the style of Asaph grew; Psalms 50, and 73-83 are in the Asaphite tradition, performed and written either by Asaph personally, or by the Guild of Musicians named after him, who carried on his legacy. While deeply rooted in their historical traditions, Asaphite psalms speak to universal themes of trust in God's sovereignty, a longing for justice, and the need for faithful worship. They challenge both individuals and communities to align themselves with God's purposes and remain steadfast in their faith, even in times of trial.

It is fitting that Psalm 75 opens by exalting the NAME of God. *"We give thanks to you O God, we give thanks, for your Name is near; men tell of your wonderful deeds"* (Psalm 75:1). In the psalm, Asaph highlights two important truths: trusting in God's timing, and humility before God.

**Trust in God's Timing** – Men often make plans according to their own timetable, without considering or consulting God's will. *"You say, 'I choose the appointed time'"* (v. 2). One who is wise will relinquish the future into the hands of God: his timing, his will.

**Humility Before God** – In men’s relationship with God, there is no room for pride. The obedient will remove pride from their hearts and accept God’s sovereignty, his justice and faithfully worship him. “To the arrogant I say, ‘Boast no more’” (v. 4).
