

#### Finding My Worth in God

"Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in Iowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself" (Phil 2:3 NKJV).

In fact, the Bible tells us that the first step to wholeness is understanding and accepting our own wretchedness and turning in utter dependence to God's awesome grace. Perhaps the old children's song has more practical advice on developing selfesteem than all of today's pop-psychology: "Jesus first, yourself LAST, and others in-between."


