A Deposit

“Now it is God who has made us for this very purpose and has given us the Spirit as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come” (2 Corinthians 5:5).

A deposit guaranteeing

Perhaps a bit of a surprise, but this is a banking metaphor or at least a reference to the world of finance! Paul is saying that God has given the Holy Spirit as a "down payment" or "deposit" to assure believers of their full redemption and eternal life. Just as a financial deposit is a guarantee of future payment, “earnest money”, the Holy Spirit is God's guarantee of our future resurrection and life with Him.

The guarantee is inferred from the function of the Greek word **ἀραβών arrabōn**, translated here as ‘deposit’; but the word is also used to mean ‘pledge’ or ‘down payment’—this first installment (in the form of the Holy Spirit), paid by God, is the certainty that more (eternal life) is to come; the deposit itself serves as the guarantee. Given that we know it is very hard for a rich man to enter the kingdom of heaven, I think it is a great idea that Paul in this passage has changed the currency from coins to the presence of the Holy Spirit: the only currency that is worth banking, and which never devalues, is that of the heart filled with the love of God’s Spirit.

What is to come

The Bible gives us snippets about heaven and eternal life. And, although our inquiring minds want to know more, the scriptures give us just enough information to make heaven a place we don’t want to miss out on.

“What is to come” is far beyond our ability to imagine. “What is to come” is so indescribable that the Bible uses precious elements like gold, silver, rubies and diamonds to describe heaven’s splendor and glory. Most of all, “what is to come” involves being in the eternal presence of Jesus: “And so we will be with the Lord forever” (1 Thessalonians 4:17).


